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EXPLANATORY NOTES

INTRODUCTION

1. This edition continues the series of publications on a calendar year basis presenting statistical information on the scheduled operations of international airlines operating into/out of Australia.
2. The figures in this publication were obtained from reports submitted by scheduled international carriers and are the best available at the time of publication.

COVERAGE

3. These statistics show **uplift/discharge** data – These data detail, by direction, the revenue traffic between the actual points of uplift and discharge within each flight, aggregated for all flights within the period. It shows the movement of traffic between two airports not necessarily directly connected but within the same flight number. Typically, flight numbers change when an aircraft reaches its home country. This means that uplift/discharge data for the port in the operator's home country are likely to be overstated by traffic whose origin/destination point is beyond that port. For example, uplift/discharge traffic reported in this publication as Singapore could include traffic whose origin/destination is Europe.
4. These statistics cover **revenue** traffic carried by the operators of scheduled regular public international air transport services only and **do not include charter traffic**.
5. Some airlines (generally, dedicated freighter operators) operate scheduled services into Australia but operate non-scheduled services out of Australia and therefore outbound activity is not recorded in this data collection.

PRODUCTION AND INTERPRETATION

6. **Tables 1 to 3** show the country of the relevant uplift or discharge port served by that airline. For example, traffic uplifted/discharged between Sydney and Singapore by British Airways would be shown as Singapore traffic in Tables 1 to 3.
7. **Table 4** shows figures for the country of service (or route) for each airline and therefore may not equate to the data in Tables 1 to 3. For example, the British Airways UK service identified in Table 4 could include passengers uplifted or discharged in Singapore or Thailand as well as the UK; these passengers would be shown individually under those countries in Tables 1 to 3. The difference in treatment of data between Tables 1 to 3 and Table 4 is necessary in order to work out a meaningful Seat Utilisation figure for Table 4.

Figures shown in Table 4 may include **total traffic** into and out of Australia for airlines that fly through Australia (also necessary in order to work out a meaningful Seat Utilisation figure). Therefore, figures in Table 4 may not equate to figures in Tables 1 to 3. For example, passengers carried by Qantas Airways from New Zealand **via** Australia to the UK will be included in Table 4 but will not be included in Tables 1 to 3 as these passengers were not uplifted/discharged in Australia.

8. **Tables 6 and 7** – show uplift/discharge passenger and freight data for directly connected city pairs. Statistics reported in these tables for city pairs without direct international flight connections, reflect carriage on interconnecting domestic services by Australian carriers within Australia or foreign carriers in their home countries. This traffic should be interpreted as increasing the volume of traffic between the primary international ports rather than as an indicator of traffic volume between ports without direct international flight connections. It should be noted however, that there is no double counting of traffic. For example, there is no direct connection between Brisbane and Los Angeles and the traffic reported between Brisbane and Los Angeles should be interpreted as adding to traffic between Sydney and Los Angeles.
9. Where figures have been rounded, discrepancies may occur between sums of component items and totals, and in percentage changes which are derived from figures prior to rounding.
10. Published figures may be revised where figures missing at the time of publication are received or misreporting/miscalculation necessitates revisions.

DEFINITIONS

11. The following definitions have been used in this publication:

- (a) Aircraft Movement: A landing or a take off.
- (b) Freight: The aggregate of all revenue freight uplifted.
- (c) Mail: The aggregate of all mail uplifted.
- (d) Revenue Passengers: see paragraph 13 below.
- (e) Seat Utilisation: The ratio of passengers carried to seats available, expressed as a percentage.
- (f) Seats Available: Generally based on standard aircraft configuration, the aggregate of seats available on all flights operated over a particular service.
- (g) Services: Scheduled flights over authorised routes which are listed according to the main ports involved.

CHANGES IN THIS PUBLICATION

- 12. Code Share Arrangements - Reporting of traffic split by airline code for code share arrangements has been phased out from January 2000. ALL traffic carried is reported under the operating airline regardless of code share arrangements for July 2000 and onwards. Airlines or services that operated only on a code share basis and hence were affected by this change are footnoted in Tables 1 to 4.
- 13. Revenue Passenger Definition - The following New definition was phased in from January 2000 and fully implemented for July 2000 and onwards: All passengers paying any fare (frequent flyer redemption passengers will be regarded as revenue passengers). In most cases, Revenue Passengers will now include all passengers excluding Free Of Charge passengers and positioning crew. The old definition was: The aggregate of all passengers paying 25% or more of the standard air fare (as defined by ICAO).
- 14. Passenger Numbers - The Revenue Passenger definition change could result in approximately a three per cent increase in passenger numbers over a full period (month or year). The growth in passenger numbers for 2000 when compared to 1999 will include a component due to the definition change.
- 15. Airline Market Shares - Due to the phased introduction of the above changes (some airlines implemented the changes between January and June 2000 while others did not do so until July 2000), airline market shares will not be accurate for January to June 2000 and hence, also for the year ended December 2000 figures in this publication.

INTERNATIONAL AVIATION INDUSTRY ANALYSIS

YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 2000

General

The year ended December 2000 saw an increase of 10.0% in the number of revenue passengers carried on international scheduled air services to and from Australia when compared with the previous year. This compares to an increase of 5.3% for 1999 over 1998. Freight carried decreased slightly by 0.2% for 2000 over 1999 compared to an increase of 7.9% for 1999 over 1998.

Passengers

Chart 1 shows total passenger traffic for the years ended December 1990 to 2000. The average annual growth rate was 6.8% over this period (inbound 6.7% and outbound 6.9%). Strong year on year growth has been recorded over this period except for 1991 when traffic was affected by the Gulf War and 1998 when traffic was affected by the Asian economic crisis.

Passengers by City Pairs

The top ten city pairs for the year ended December 2000 represented 37.7% of the total passenger traffic. This compares with 36.7% for 1999 and 35.4% for 1998. The distribution of traffic amongst the top ten city pairs as a percentage of total passengers for the latest year is shown in Chart 2.

Table 1 shows total passenger traffic by city pairs for the years ended December 1998, 1999 and 2000. Of the top ten city pairs, Auckland/Sydney remains the busiest with 5.7% of the total for the latest year. The top two city pairs recorded the most significant increases in traffic with Singapore/Sydney recording 23.8% growth and Auckland/Sydney recording 20.1% growth for the year ended December 2000. All the other major city pairs recorded increases in traffic over the same period.

Airline Market Share - Passengers

The top ten carriers for the year ended December 2000 accounted for 82.7% of the total passenger market (see Chart 3), compared with 83.3% in 1999 and 82.0% in 1998. The market share attributable to Australian carriers for the year ended December 2000 of 37.2%, compares with 38.7% in 1999 and 40.5% in 1998.

During 2000, 54 international scheduled airlines operated services to/from Australia of which 8 were dedicated freight only operators (airlines operating only via code share arrangements have been excluded). This compares to a total of 53 international scheduled airlines during 1999 of which 8 were dedicated freight only operators. Total flights of 91.2 thousand and seats of 23.9 million operated by the airlines into and out of Australia during 2000 compares to 82.6 thousand flights and 21.9 million seats in 1999 and 79.0 thousand flights and 21.6 million seats in 1998. Overall seat utilisation percentage (load factor) was 70.2% in 2000, 69.6% in 1999 and 67.4% in 1998.

Freight

The average annual growth for total freight was 6.7% over the last ten years (inbound 6.6% and outbound 6.7%). Asian Express Airlines, Cargolux Airlines International, Connie Kalitta Services, Evergreen International Airlines (mainly on behalf of Qantas Airways), Federal Express Corporation, Martinair Holland, Polar Air Cargo and United Parcel Service operated dedicated freighter services to/from Australia during 2000. As well as these freight only operators, Cathay Pacific, China Airlines, Korean Air, Malaysia Airlines and Singapore Airlines operated dedicated freighter services in addition to their regular passenger services (airlines operating via code share arrangements have not been included). Qantas Airways had the largest share of freight carried to and from Australia in 2000 with 23.5% of the total, followed by Singapore Airlines with 15.2% and Air New Zealand with 9.3%.

Freight by City Pairs


Table 2 shows total freight carried by city pairs for the years ended December 1998, 1999 and 2000. The top ten city pairs for the year ended December 2000 accounted for 48.8% of total freight traffic, compared with 49.4% for 1999 and 47.0% for 1998. Auckland/Sydney remains the major contributor with 7.4% of the total freight for the latest year. Seoul/Sydney (52.6%) and Singapore/Brisbane (22.3%) recorded the most significant increases for the year ended December 2000. Auckland/Melbourne (-14.9%) and Auckland/Sydney (-10.6%) recorded the most significant decreases in freight carried over the same period.

Passengers by Major Country

Table 3 provides a breakdown of passenger traffic by major country for the years ended December 1998, 1999 and 2000. The ten major countries for the year ended December 2000 accounted for 84.1% of total passenger traffic. This compares to 82.7% for 1999 and 82.8% for 1998. New Zealand was the major contributor in each of the three years, with 19.9% of the total market in the latest year and 19.0% in 1999 and 1998. Korea (35.6%) and USA (18.7%) recorded the most significant increases for the year ended December 2000. All the other major countries recorded increases in traffic over the same period.

Passenger Movements at International Airports

Table 4 provides a breakdown of passenger traffic through Australian international airports for the years ended December 1998, 1999 and 2000. Sydney accounted for 50.0% of the total passenger traffic for the latest year (up 0.7% over previous year), followed by Melbourne with 18.5% (up 0.8% over previous year) and Brisbane with 14.9% (down 1.0% over previous year). Melbourne, Sydney and Perth have all shown steady growth over the two year period, with passenger traffic through Melbourne increasing by 22.3%, through Sydney by 18.8% and through Perth by 10.2%.







CHART 3: INTERNATIONAL PASSENGERS BY MAJOR AIRLINES, YEAR ENDED DECEMBER 2000

- A total of 54 international scheduled airlines operated services to/from Australia during 2000 (including dedicated freight airlines but excluding those airlines operating via code share arrangements only).

- The year ended December 2000 saw an increase of 10.0% in the number of revenue passengers carried on international scheduled air services to and from Australia when compared with the previous year.
- In terms of freight carried, 2000 saw a slight decrease of 0.2% when compared with 1999.
- The top five airlines in terms of passengers carried were Qantas Airways (34.0% of total), Air New Zealand (10.9%), Singapore Airlines (10.5%), Malaysia Airlines (5.9%) and Japan Airlines (4.2%).
- The top five airlines in terms of freight carried were Qantas Airways (23.5% of total), Singapore Airlines (15.2%), Air New Zealand (9.3%), Cathay Pacific Airways (7.1%) and Malaysia Airlines (5.6%).
- The top five city pairs in terms of passengers carried were Auckland/Sydney (5.7% of total), Singapore/Sydney (5.3%), Los Angeles/Sydney (4.9%), Hong Kong/Sydney (4.1%) and Singapore/Perth (3.8%).
- The top five city pairs in terms of freight carried were Auckland/Sydney (7.4% of total), Singapore/Melbourne (7.1%), Singapore/Sydney (6.8%), Hong Kong/Sydney (5.0%) and Los Angeles/Sydney (4.8%).
- Sydney accounted for 50.0% of total passenger traffic and for 48.3% of total freight traffic during 2000. Melbourne was the next busiest airport with 18.5% of passenger traffic and 29.3% of freight traffic, followed by Brisbane with 14.9% of passenger traffic and 11.6% of freight traffic.
