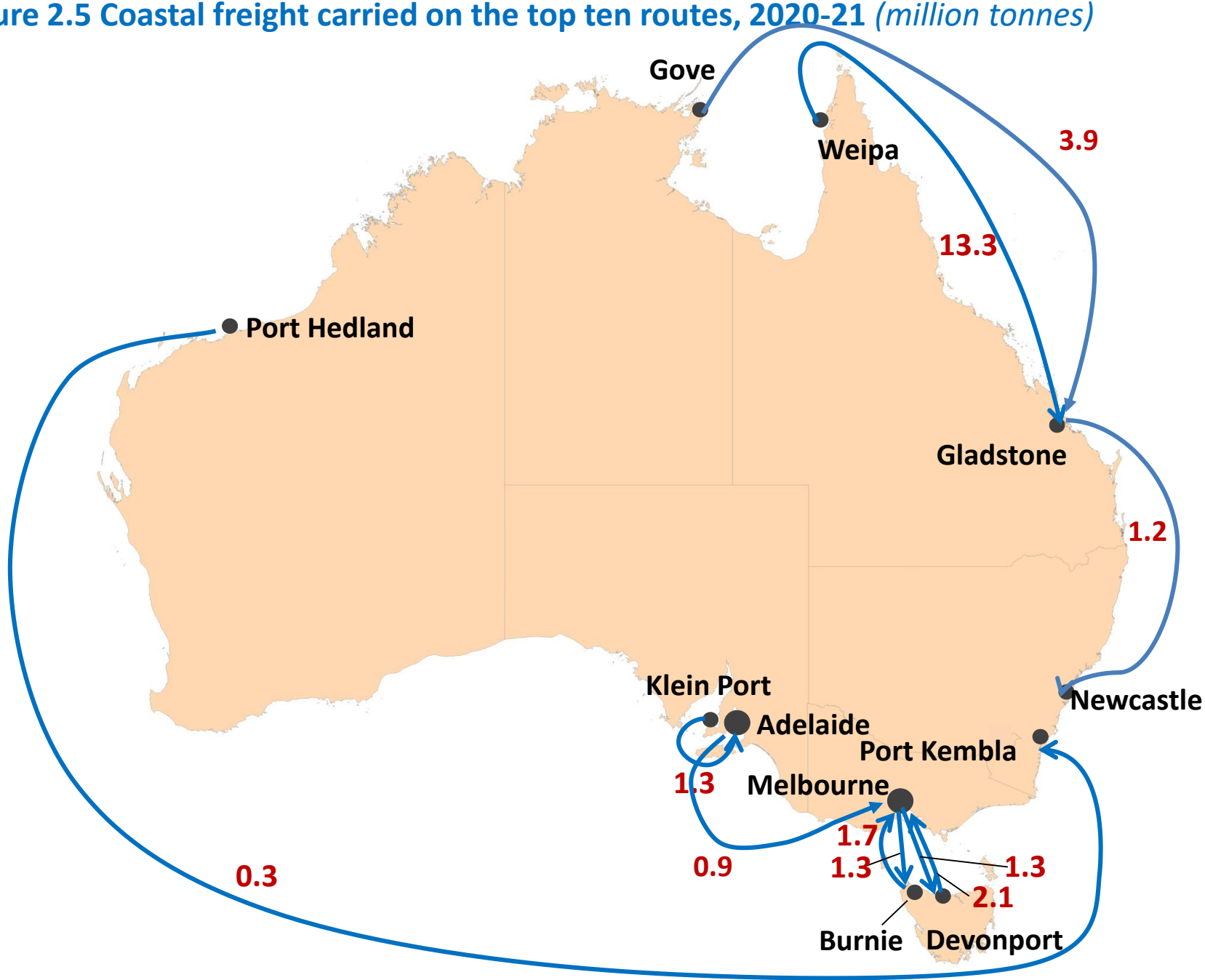


Figure 2.5 Coastal freight carried on the top ten routes, 2020-21 (*million tonnes*)



Notes: The top ten routes for coastal freight flow are selected based on the summed coastal freight over the ten years to 2020–21, though the volume illustrated in the chart is for the most recent financial year. In some cases the statistics for several nearby ports are included in one heading, mainly because of difficulties in clearly identifying exact freight origins and destinations. The full list of ports and grouped ports/terminals/facilities is in “Appendix A: Australian ports”
For example, Sydney in this report includes Port Botany, Botany Bay, Gore Bay, Glebe Island, Kurnell, Port Jackson and White Bay. Fremantle in this report also includes Kwinana. Weipa in this report also includes Amrun.
